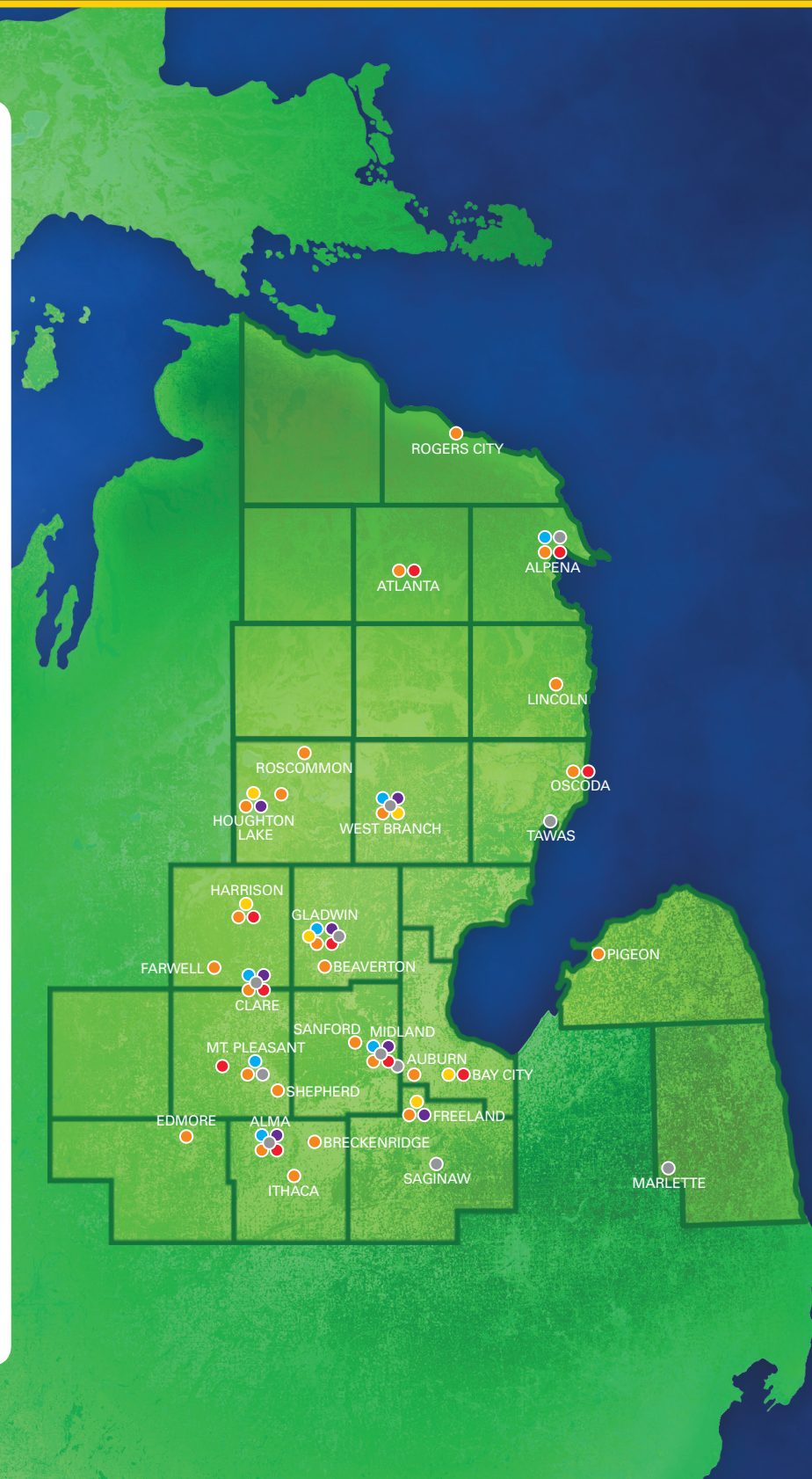

MidMichigan Health is a non-profit health system, headquartered in Midland, affiliated with Michigan Medicine, the health care division of the University of Michigan. Serving more than 938,000 residents in a 23-county region, MidMichigan Health has medical centers in seven cities and offers both home health care and physician services. MidMichigan Physicians Group provides urgent care and medical offices in more than 30 specialties and subspecialties.

MidMichigan Health traces its history back to 1984 with an affiliation between what was then Midland Hospital Center and Clare Osteopathic Hospital. Since then, MidMichigan has grown into a regional health system including 11 wholly-owned subsidiaries providing a wide range of health care services to communities throughout Michigan. As a tax-exempt health system, all excess revenues go back into providing care, upgrading services, fairly compensating employees and creating a supportive work environment. During fiscal year 2019, MidMichigan Health provided more than \$90 million in charity care, community benefits and other uncompensated care.

Affiliated with Michigan Medicine

MidMichigan Health is aligned in a clinical and business partnership with Michigan Medicine, the academic medical center of the University of Michigan. A national leader in advanced patient care, innovative research, and the training of physicians and medical scientists, Michigan Medicine is known for world-class medicine. The partnership between MidMichigan and Michigan Medicine is intended to expand access, quality, and the level of care for patients who live in the 23-county region served by MidMichigan Health. Benefits to our patients include:

- Local access to University of Michigan specialists through local clinics and telemedicine
- Expedited admissions when our patients need to travel to Ann Arbor for specialized care, plus close coordination of care to minimize travel and improve communication and outcomes
- Providers at both organizations share clinical protocols, best practices, research, consulting and educational opportunities, which enhances clinical expertise and access to advanced treatments. For example, MidMichigan Health providers participate in Cancer Conferences, clinical trials and continuing medical education seminars along with Michigan Medicine providers



Milestones



2018 | Board of Directors approved a \$59 million expansion and renovation to build an inpatient tower featuring private patient rooms.

2016 | A \$75 million Emergency Department renovation was completed. The new space included 20 private rooms and significant upgrades to technology and medical equipment.

The Medical Center affiliated with MidMichigan Health in April 2016.

2014 | Alpena was the first in Michigan to have a Samsung Fully-Automated Digital X-ray System.

2007 | The Center for Wound Healing & Hyperbaric Medicine opened in partnership with NOAA Thunder Bay National Marine Sanctuary.

2006 | The HealthPlex opened featuring state-of-the-art equipment, a warm-water aqua therapy pool, and fully integrated rehabilitation.

2004 | The new Inpatient Rehabilitation Unit opened with 11 private rooms.

2003 | Auxiliary donations to the Medical Center reached \$1 million and the Auxiliary celebrated its 30th anniversary.

2001 | The Cancer Center, in partnership with the University of Michigan Health System, opened.

1995 | The Medical Center was one of only four hospitals in the state to launch a website.

1993 | The Development Council, whose focus is developing widespread community and financial support for the hospital, was established with Dr. Robert Currier as chair.

1987 | Alpena received its first CT scanner.

1978 | The Medical Center's Board of Directors approved plans to double the size of the hospital. The \$20 million project was completed in 1985 and included a 72-bed tower of patient rooms.

1974 | A \$3.4 million expansion project was completed which included a new lab, additional laundry area and the Emergency Room's outpatient facilities.

1962 | A Chronic Disease and Rehabilitation Unit, as well as an Intensive Care Unit were added.

1942 | With an average daily census of 105 patients in a hospital built to accommodate 70, plans to add a \$1 million, three-story wing bringing the hospital capacity to 134 beds was made. Construction also included a new surgery facility, new entrance and a physical therapy department.

1940 | Hailed as the only modern hospital in northeast Michigan, Alpena General Hospital was opened with 88-beds, two major operating rooms, X-ray department, maternity unit with 11 bassinets, children's ward, 11 private rooms and a pathology laboratory. It cost \$258,181 and the first baby was born two days after opening.
