# DU YOU KNOW THE SIGNS **OF CONTROL?**

People often think their asthma is under control, but it may not be. So to help you DU MORE with less asthma, it's important to understand the current level of your asthma control. This is a vital step in helping you and your doctor decide if your current asthma medications are enough.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION: Before using DUPIXENT, tell your healthcare provider about all your medical conditions, including if you: have a parasitic (helminth) infection; are scheduled to receive any vaccinations. You should not receive a "live vaccine" if you are treated with DUPIXENT. ### **EVOLVING ASTHMA SCIENCE.**

Scientific advances have found that Type 2 inflammation is one of the major sources of persistent, moderate-to-severe asthma. Asthma that is caused by Type 2 inflammation is known as Type 2 asthma.

With moderate-to-severe asthma, there's a constant underlying inflammation in the lungs, regardless of whether you have any symptoms. When you breathe in something like pet dander or other allergens, your immune system reacts aggressively and increases the inflammation. This can cause your asthma symptoms to get worse and can result in an attack.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION: Before using DUPIXENT, tell your healthcare provider about all your medical conditions, including if you (cont'd): are pregnant or plan to become pregnant. It is not known whether DUPIXENT will harm your unborn baby. There is a pregnancy exposure registry for women who take DUPIXENT during pregnancy to collect information about the health of you and your baby. Your healthcare provider can enroll you or you may enroll yourself. While oral steroids are helpful when prescribed, there is some medical concern over long-term use: mood changes, weight gain, diabetes, and vision problems.†

This may happen in people who also take a steroid medicine by mouth that is being stopped or the dose is being lowered. It is not known whether this is caused by DUPIXENT. Tell your healthcare provider right away if you have: rash, shortness of breath, persistent fever, chest pain, or a feeling of pins and needles or numbness of your arms or legs. What does "DU MORE" really mean? It's simple: you DU-ing you, whatever that may be. In clinical studies, people taking DUPIXENT saw a meaningful improvement in their day-to-day lives, which included less shortness of breath and wheezing, not waking at night, and being less limited in their normal activities. The relationship between DUPIXENT and these results was studied but not definitively proven. Ask your doctor how DUPIXENT may help.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION: The most common side effects in patients with asthma include injection site reactions, pain in the throat (oropharyngeal pain), and high count of a certain white blood cell (eosinophilia). ### NOT AN INHALER. NOT A STEROID.

DUPIXENT is something different: the only dual-targeting biologic treatment for moderate-to-severe asthma. It's given as an injection under the skin (subcutaneous). And it's good

to know you only have to take it twice a month. Talk to your doctor to find out if DUPIXENT is right for you.

WANT TO REDUCE OR ELIMINATE ORAL STEROIDS IN YOUR LIFE? DUPIXENT MAY BE THE ANSWER.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION: Use DUPIXENT exactly as prescribed. Your healthcare provider will tell you how much DUPIXENT to inject and how often to inject it. DUPIXENT is an injection given under the skin (subcutaneous injection). If your healthcare provider decides that you or a caregiver can give DUPIXENT injections, you or your caregiver should receive training on the right way to prepare and inject DUPIXENT. Do not try to inject DUPIXENT until you have been shown the right way by your healthcare provider. In children 12 years of age and older, it is recommended that DUPIXENT be administered by or under supervision of an adult. Please see additional

### THERE ARE OTHER OPTIONS FOR SUPPORT.

Those who may qualify must be at least 12 years old, a resident of the 50 United States, the District of Columbia, or Puerto Rico, and demonstrate a financial need with a total annual adjusted gross income of \$100,000 or less.
