About MidMichigan Health

MidMichigan Health is a non-profit health system, headquartered in Midland, affiliated with Michigan Medicine, the health care division of the University of Michigan. Serving more than 938,000 residents in a 23-county region, MidMichigan Health has medical centers in seven cities and offers both home health care and physician services. MidMichigan Physicians Group provides urgent care and medical offices in more than 30 specialties and subspecialties.

MidMichigan Health traces its history back to 1984 with an affiliation between what was then Midland Hospital Center and Clare Osteopathic Hospital. Since then, MidMichigan has grown into a regional health system including 11 wholly-owned subsidiaries providing a wide range of health care services to communities throughout Michigan. As a tax-exempt health system, all excess revenues go back into providing care, upgrading services, fairly compensating employees and creating a supportive work environment. During fiscal year 2019, MidMichigan Health provided more than \$90 million in charity care, community benefits and other uncompensated care.

MidMichigan also contributes significantly to the health of our local economies. As the largest employer in Midland, Gratiot, Alpena, Gladwin and Ogemaw Counties, and second largest employer in Clare County, MidMichigan employs more than 6,100 people who, combined, earn more than \$494 million in annual wages and benefits.

Consistent with our mission. MidMichigan Health is dedicated to providing excellent health care and improving the quality of life for people in our communities and has a long tradition of being a partner in community health by leveraging our resources to improve the places where our communities live, work and play.

In partnership with other community agencies, we regularly conduct a Community Health Needs Assessment (CHNA) to identify the health needs of the residents in our communities. Based on the findings, MidMichigan Health creates action plans to ensure that we are providing excellent services to all of our communities.

This excellence in services to both patients and employees has a history of receiving many distinguished awards. In fact, in 2019, MidMichigan Health was ranked in the top 20 percent (quintile) for balanced performance among small health systems nationwide by IBM Watson Health™ for the third year in a row. This included MidMichigan being named one of the nation's 15 Top Health Systems® by Truven Health Analytics™ (now IBM Watson Health) in 2016, which also landed the health system in the top 20 percent.


